En algunas ocasiones se hace referencia a las diferencias entre el inglés británico y el americano, por considerarse éstas las dos variedades con mayor difusión de la lengua inglesa. Asimismo, se tiene en cuenta permanentemente a lo largo de esta obra el hecho de que la gran mayoría de los estudiantes de la UNED son hablantes de español como lengua materna, y, por lo tanto, las explicaciones se han orientado de forma pedagógica siguiendo un enfoque contrastivo.
