Overcoming School Refusal Brill Schoningh
 History texts studied by students in schools are an important field for drawing boundaries between nations, beliefs, ethnic groups and countries, sometimes causing disputes and protests. Even in the democratic and peaceful Nordic countries, history texts carry a message of authorized content knowledge and situated values. At the same time, they are meant to foster the critical mind, a skillful eye and a tolerant spirit. In this volume, scholars from Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden explore the question of "Us and the Others" in Nordic textbooks and educational media and focus on teachers' opinions and use of history texts, partly based on a survey among Nordic history teachers in elementary and secondary schools. The questions dealt with are of national identity and multiculturalism, sameness and difference, content and pedagogy, skills and values, goals of history education and teachers' situations. The scholars and teachers compare the educational and societal aims with the actual teaching materials at hand. The potentialities and limitations of textbooks and other educational media are investigated and discussed.

 When did you last tell your children to put their hand over their mouth when they yawn? When did you last suggest that when they are introduced to someone they should shake hands firmly and look them in the eye? Do you suggest that they should wait until everyone is served before they eat rather than Hoover up the best bit for themselves? Do you demand that your young daughter dress decorously lest she elicit outraged looks? Do you think that the children of today have disgraceful manners? Unlike, of course, when you were young ... Well, that's certainly what Erasmus of Rotterdam thought in 1530 when he published *De Civilitate Morum Puerilium: A Handbook on Good Manners for Children*. He felt that learning good manners was crucial to a child's upbringing, and that the uncouth and ill-disciplined behaviour around him demanded a new kind of book. After all, as William of Wykeham memorably said in the 1350s, 'Manners maketh man'. *A Handbook on Good Manners for Children* is considered to be the first treatise in Western Europe on the moral and practical education of children. It was a massive bestseller - indeed the biggest-selling book of the sixteenth century - going into 130 editions over 300 years and being translated into 22 languages within ten years of its publication. In it, Erasmus concerns himself with matters such as how to dress, how to behave at table, how to converse with one's elders and

contemporaries, how to address the opposite sex and much else. For example: Table Manners 'It's just as rude to lick greasy fingers as it is to wipe them on your clothing, Use a cloth or napkin instead.' 'Some people, no sooner than they've sat down, immediately stick their hands into the dishes of food. This is the manner of wolves.' 'Making a raucous noise or shrieking intentionally when you sneeze, or showing off by carrying on sneezing on purpose, is very ill-mannered.' 'To fidget around in your seat, and to settle first on one buttock and then the next, gives the impression that you are repeatedly farting, or trying to fart.' The advice is as relevant today as it was 500 years ago.

 The goal of the report is to describe the operation of the German criminal justice system and provide the latest available data for each stage of the criminal justice process, from the police level through prosecution, sentencing, probation, and reconviction. Data also describe the penal institutions in Germany, such as the scale and nature of imprisonment and information about prisoners and length of imprisonment. This year's report focuses on the special topic of Offender-Victim Mediation, which has received greater attention in Germany since 1999, quadrupling in use since 1993. The number of crimes recorded by police has risen steadily since 1963; there were 5.3 million recorded crimes in 1993, more than 3 times the number of crimes recorded in 1963. Serious crimes against the person are rare, with only 4 homicides recorded for every 100,000 inhabitants. Once suspects are arrested, crime cases are passed from the police to the Public Prosecution Office, which dealt with 4,766,070 investigative proceedings at the regional and local court level and 2,604 investigative proceedings at the higher regional court level in 2003. Following a description of how the courts are organized and how they process cases, data are offered on the sentencing of adults and juveniles. The number and type of probation orders, as well as the reasons for the probation orders, are reviewed and data on re-conviction is presented that shows only approximately 35 percent of juveniles who were released from prison in 1994 were re-convicted during the 4 years directly following release. Written about the year 400. [Faustus was undoubtedly the acutest, most determined and most unscrupulous opponent of orthodox Christianity in the age of Augustin. The occasion of Augustin's great writing against him was the publication of Faustus' attack on the Old Testament Scriptures, and on the New Testament so far as it was at variance with Manichæan error. Faustus seems to have followed in the footsteps of Adimantus, against whom Augustin had written some years before, but to have gone considerably beyond Adimantus in the recklessness of his statements. The incarnation of Christ, involving his birth from a woman, is one of the main points of attack. He makes the variations in the genealogical records of the Gospels a ground for rejecting the whole as spurious. He supposed the Gospels, in their present form, to be not the works of the Apostles, but rather of later Judaizing falsifiers. The entire Old Testament system he treats with the utmost contempt, blaspheming the Patriarchs, Moses, the Prophets, etc., on the ground of their private lives and their teachings. Most of the objections to the morality of the Old Testament that are now current were already familiarly used in the time of Augustin. Augustin's answers are only partially satisfactory, owing to his imperfect view of the relation of the old dispensation to the new; but in the age in which they were written they were doubtless very effective. The writing is interesting from the point of view of Biblical criticism, as well as from that of polemics against Manichæism.--A.H.N.]

Herrschaft wird im ›Prosalancelot‹ in vielfältiger Weise und an ganz unterschiedlichen Figuren diskutiert. Artus, der mächtigste und wichtigste Herrscher, ist oberster Lehnsherr und führt den Vorsitz über die Tafelrunde. Beiden Aufgaben muss er gerecht werden, auch wenn sich dies aufgrund unterschiedlicher und teils gegenläufiger Hierarchien schwierig gestaltet. Seine Herrschaft ist nur dort erfolgreich, wo es ihm gelingt, feudale rechtliche und höfische Normen miteinander auszutarieren. Flankiert wird Artus von zwei gegnerischen Herrschern: Claudas, der Usurpator, handelt fast ausschließlich aus realpolitischen und feudale rechtlichen Beweggründen. Galahot dagegen gibt bereitwillig jegliches Gut auf, um die Freundschaft des höfischsten aller Ritter zu erlangen – Lancelot. Beide liefern damit eine Folie, auf der die Artusfigur neu gelesen werden kann. The German 'Prose Lancelot' discusses rulership in many different ways using very different characters. Arthur, the most powerful and most important ruler, is the supreme liege lord and presides over the Round Table. He must do justice to both his vassals and his knights, even if this is difficult due to different and sometimes contradictory hierarchies. His rule is only stable when he succeeds in balancing feudal and courtly norms, whenever he does not, the realm suffers greatly. Arthur is complemented by two opposing rulers: Claudas, the usurper, acts almost exclusively for reasons of politics and feudal law. Galahot, on the other hand, willingly gives up any assets in order to gain the friendship of the most courtly knight – Lancelot. Both thus provide a foil on which the character of King Arthur can be re-read.
