Grace Elizabeth King (1852-1932) was an American author of Louisiana stories, history, and biography, and a leader in historical and literary activities. She was

born in New Orleans into an aristocratic family that had been impoverished by the American Civil War. She studied under Charles Gayarre and eventually found her living in writing; among her subjects were other women who had been put in the same situation. Her most famous works include *Monsieur Motte* (1888), *Tales of a Time and Place* (1892), *Balcony Stories* (1892), *The Pleasant Ways of St. Medard* (1916) and *Memories of a Southern Woman of Letters* (1932).
