National Center for O*NET
Development (the O*NET
Center) continually
collects data related to
these occupations. In
2008, DOL requested the
National Academies to
review O*NET and
consider its future
directions. In response,
the present volume
inventories and evaluates
the uses of O*NET;
explores the linkage of

This database describes more than 1,000 major jobs covering about 95% of the labor force. JIST has created a much simpler, much less expensive

version of the O*NET Interest Profiler, developed by the U.S. Department of Labor. High school-aged youth through adults are given an excellent starting place to explore jobs with this assessment. Test takers indicate whether they like or dislike 180 work activities and score their responses. Their interests are ranked within the six Holland personality types and matched with O*NET job titles. This assessment fosters self-directed behaviors and takes only 30 minutes to complete.
