Abstract: This study examined the effects of a social skills curriculum, delivered by a school counselor through large group guidance, on the behavior of sixth-grade students.

More specifically, the following question was addressed: How do the behaviors of sixth- grade students who

receive instruction in social skills differ from those who do not? The nonequivalent control group design was utilized. Students were selected from five intact classrooms. Two of the five classes were randomly assigned to the treatment group and two were randomly assigned to the control group. The fifth class was not involved in the study.
