release of the man who could become the  
nation's first prime minister, Jomo  
Kenyatta, and early negotiations for  
'Uhuru'. The history of the 'Nation' papers  
and that of Kenya are closely intertwined;  
in the heat of its printing presses and  
philosophical struggles, that story is told  
here: from committed beginnings to its  
position today as East Africa's leading  
newspaper group.
